July

On July 3, 2026, the 20th Festival of Military-Historical Clubs "Bagration" will take place at the historical and cultural complex "Stalin Line". The event is dedicated to the eponymous offensive operation of 1944, during which Soviet troops liberated Belarus and defeated Army Group Centre.
